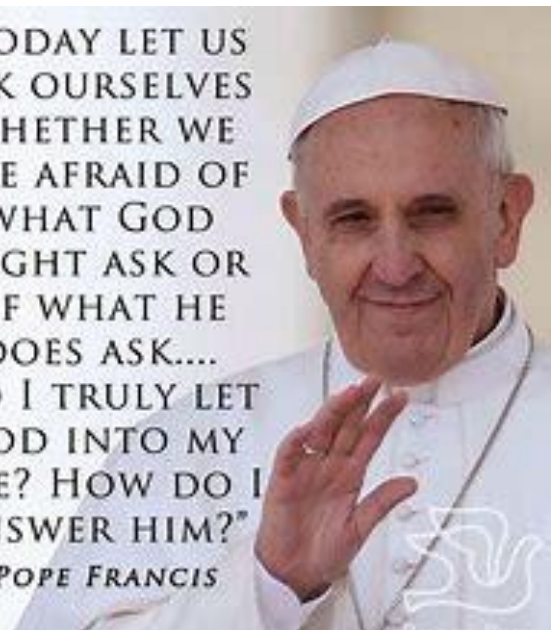

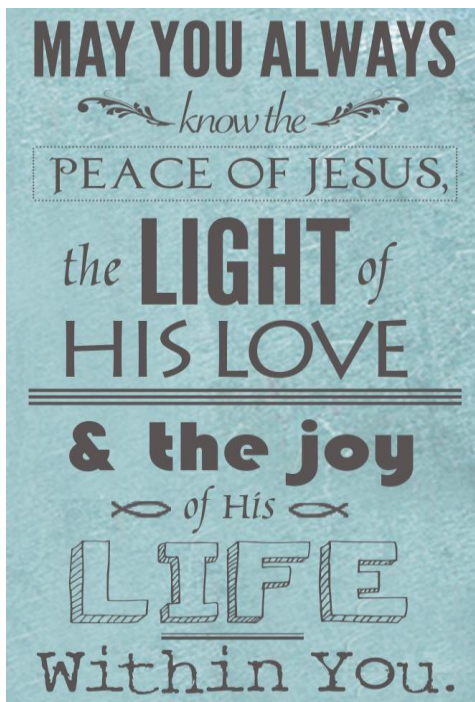

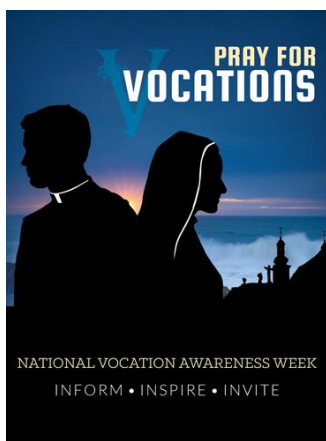

A PARISH EXERCISE

Arrive at Church 20 minutes before the starting time for Mass

As you wait, look around at those who are preparing for the celebration - not just the priest but also those who are responsible for putting out the Bulletin, playing music, or taking up the collection.

Think about the people who make up the flowers in the Church, or run outreach groups for the community. Some of their names may be in the Parish Bulletin.

At different times during the Mass there are opportunities to make your own private intentions.

Devout your prayers this week to the people in our Parish - those who you have reflected on in the time before Mass.

Pray that others might also be moved to join them in making this a Spirit-filled community.

When Mass is finished, find one of the people you have prayed about and thank them for being part of our Parish.

If you then find yourself in conversation with them, you might ask them what moves them to devote their time to our Parish.

Over the next few days, find some time to think about your own faith life.

Has this experience changed the way that you see our Parish community?

Do you feel moved to become more involved in our Parish or community?

What gifts do you have that you could share with our Parish and community?
